### **Announcement of An Extraordinary Loss (Impairment Loss on Fixed Assets)**

Dai Nippon Printing Co., Ltd. (DNP) announced today that it will book the following extraordinary loss (impairment loss on fixed assets) as part of its consolidated and non-consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025.

#### **1. Booking of an extraordinary loss (impairment loss on fixed assets)**

The DNP Group engages in continuous structural reform aimed at building a strong business portfolio that can withstand changes in the business environment. As part of these efforts, in the consolidated results for the fourth quarter of the fiscal year ended March 2025, we assessed business assets that have reduced profitability and idle assets with no prospect of future use in accordance with the "Accounting Standard for Impairment of Fixed Assets" and decided to record an impairment loss of 68.1 billion yen as an extraordinary loss. In addition, we decided to record an impairment loss of 66.9 billion yen as an extraordinary loss in our non-consolidated financial statement.

In the consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ended March 2025, we have recorded an impairment loss of 70.2 billion yen as an extraordinary loss, which includes the impairment loss recognized up to the third quarter of the fiscal year ended March 2025.

#### **2. Impact on consolidated results**

The above extraordinary loss is reflected in the "Consolidated Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2025 [J-GAAP]," published today.
